

The prize store

When you receive your tokens, there will be lots of fun and unusual things for you to purchase at the **Prize Store**. You might choose several smaller items, or go for a large item. You can browse and shop at the **Prize Store** for as long as you like during the Bike-A-Thon, but it will only be open for that day. So be sure to turn in all sponsor money when you come to ride, so you will get lots of tokens.

Awards

Awards will be presented to riders in each age group who ride the most laps. Your number of laps will be recorded for you as you ride. First awards will be presented to the 5-9 age groups about 10:15am, after the second group rides. Age 10-13 group awards will be presented at 12:15pm.

The High School group will be awarded after they finish their laps. All winners will have their pictures taken to be published in the local papers and on our website: www.youthservicebureau.org

Before the bike-a-thon

The day of the bike-a-thon

Enter Zemurray Park at the Coleman Ave. entrance. First, bring this brochure (with registration form and list of sponsors), your donation, bike & helmet and \$15 registration fee to the **Registration Table**. When you've completed your registration form and your registration fee has been turned in, you will be given your Bike-A-Thon T-shirt and a number to wear. Next, go to the **Sponsor & Prize Store Table** to turn in sponsorship money. There you will receive tokens to spend in the **Prize Store**. The amount you receive is based on the amount of sponsorships you bring. The \$15 registration fee is **NOT** counted toward your **Prize Store** tokens. You will receive a token for every \$2.50 you bring. For example, if you bring \$20 you will receive 8 tokens, for \$50 you will receive 20 tokens, for \$100 you will receive 40 tokens. Then, line up at the **Starting Line**. We will signal you to start to ride as many laps in a specified time as you want or are able to ride. There will be water stops where you can rest and get water.
